Back in 2008 there was a major change in my life. I received a ten-month jail sentence for drinking and driving. It was my fourth. I am thankful to God that I didn't hurt anyone during that time. When I went to jail I was put into a "faith pod" because the rest of the jail was full. Normally you have to make a request to be placed there. I used to call things like that coincidences. Now I call them IBMs (Itty Bitty Miracles).

Pastors would come into the pod two or three times a day and teach the Word of the Lord. At first I was bored with it but then the IBMs started happening. It got to the point where I could not get enough. I started to truly understand that is not about me. It all starts with God. Rick Warren's book *A Purpose-Driven Life* had a major impact on me.

In the past, I had a good business and did well for my family and myself but did not have the happiness and fulfillment that I have today. I thought that I did, but it was not until I opened my heart up to Jesus that I learned how good one can feel about himself and others. Since I completely turned myself over to Him and developed a "Let go and let God" way of living, things are different for me. I own and operate a hot dog stand. I don't make as much as I used to but now I am working for a different treasure. I am happy and I talk with people from all walks of life. Quite often I get the

opportunity to help the needy and enjoy doing it.

If you were to tell me a year ago that I would now enjoy going out my way to help people and give to the needy I would have told you that you were "nuts". I thank God every day for that change of mindset. Today I consider every day a blessing and an opportunity to do good. I have sometimes wondered why God had not shown me the light earlier in life

and have shared this with several mature believers. More than one suggested that God can use my experiences for His purposes. I am hoping that God will give me the opportunity to go back into the jail (this time through the front door) to help other inmates by sharing my experience and hope. Chaplain Frank of the Sarasota County jail use to say "if I could just get one of you". Maybe I could get one, too.

I remember the time when I first met Don Batterman. He teaches the FIT program and goes into the jail on his own time. I said to myself "this guy is crazy to do this for nothing". Now I pray to be just like him because I see he is in it for everything, not for nothing. He is doing exactly what he was spiritually gifted to be doing and will be reward in eternity. He is building a fortune in heavenly treasure that cannot rot, mildew, or be stolen. God bless him and everyone who does God's work and enjoys doing it.

True love will realistically address at least the most important things before marriage and resolve them in a way that is fully communicated and understood.
