Four More Trained in Florida Panhandle

Enthusiasm was high for the second successful training at the Harvest Vineyard Mission in just a few months. Harvest Vineyard is a recovery house for those who have fallen on hard times and need a place to get themselves together. The ministry recently purchased a former state prison property and operates halfway houses, one for men and one for women. This is the first community-based effort by FIT in the Panhandle area and we are very excited about the opportunities. Interest is high in the area, and yet another training may be necessary to create ministries for people who are wanting them.

Board Member Beverly Shatterly reports four graduations in the region in the last quarter and two more are near. Graduations are at Okaloosa Correctional Institution, Crestview, FL; Jackson Correctional Institute, Malone, Fl; Blackwater River Facility, Milton, FL. This involves ten regular facilitators and three peer (inmate) facilitators who have been specially trained. Beverly is also networking with local churches to encourage them and assist in extending their ministries into the local prisons.

Twelve New Leaders in Lakeland, FL

Lighthouse Ministries Inc. was the gracious host of our Leader Training session in Lakeland, FL. This ministry has a men's and a women's residential center and has been using the FIT program since 2012. Most of the attendees of this session were there to supplement their already-active team. The Men's Center has seen 171 course graduations and the Women's 162.

Also in attendance were persons from the Zoe's Journey women's residential center. Zoe's Journey has been using the curriculum since 2011 and has seen 338 course completions.

In the past fifteen months, there have been 46 course graduations recorded there as well as 828 contact-hours. They have graduating classes every quarter.

This brings the number of jails served to eight. The others are located in the Florida cities of Key West, Naples, Ft. Myers, Sarasota, Palmetto, Land O Lakes, and Bartow.


