On December 6th, a graduation banquet and ceremony was held at the center for those who completed the Finance and the Parenting curriculum. The facilitated classes are made for this kind of environment. The participants add their ideas to what they hear and learn, making an amazing course very powerful! Not only do the courses change their lives, but they have become friends and added themselves to the strength of the center with their participation in center outreach opportunities.

I believe that we become a part of the ministry started by Christ when He went out into the streets, touched people’s lives, and changed the world. Financial Course

“I came to the Dream Center to volunteer in the capacity of “teaching”. I was at a crossroads in my life where I knew it was time to serve as a volunteer somewhere in the community or I

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would never “get out of my Self”; i.e., my self-centered life... I quickly found my role as a facilitator, rather than a teacher, very comfortable, enjoyable. It did not take long for me to feel so liberated towards the curriculum study because the course is Christian faith-based and we used prayer to start the class, prayer to close, and often, during. In each lesson the section called Scriptural Principles brought us back to what the Bible says about how we should be managing our affairs. This was the first time I have been able to freely express my faith in God with other people in a learning situation and it felt wonderful... I know in my heart that the Holy Spirit was the enhancer of my skills, making me use my ears more and guiding my speaking to be more effective than what I could do on my own. The Lord truly sent me to the Dream Center. We grew to care about each other and often called each other at home in between classes. It was amazing how non-judgmental everyone was and how close and sensitive we became. When the people first came to the class they thought it would be managed like the school classes they knew. They thrived in this interactive group setting. It empowered them, feeling worthy to others. I believe after what I saw develop in everyone, that this course will have lasting effects on the people who worked through it.”
