Learn to Fish Women's Recovery House at Fundraiser Event

FIT has worked closely with Learn to Fish Recovery in Bradenton, FL since 2010. Nearly everyone in the photo has been involved in FIT courses. Each week two to three different FIT classes are conducted by a facilitator team from both the center and Journey Assembly of God. There have been 328 course completions and 3,722 contact hours. Makeup classes are also offered in-house for those who need them. Learn to Fish residents have provided much of the feedback for our field testing of new curricula, such as *Coping with the Losses of Life* and *Dating and Marriage*.

The Journey Church team services both Learn to Fish and the FIT Lab at FIT headquarters. The Lab works with local agencies each week by providing courses for those needing required courses for sentencing or to regain custody of children. It uses advanced
