- Steve Heintz reports expansion of the work at Suwannee Correctional Institution in North Florida.
- Preliminary work has started on producing a new FIT course on "starting over". It will focus on the needs of prisons, jails, and recovery houses that are working with clients with only a limited time left before transitioning into society.
- Joseph Sheehan is expanding the work at Century Correctional Institution in West Florida.
- Certified Trainers John Ringleb and Joseph Sheehan have been especially active in training inmates to teach other inmates in FIT's organized "peer facilitator" program.
- Eight new peer facilitators have been approved by the FIT Board in 2019.
- Chris Christiansen and team have been invited to expand into other buildings at Taylor Correctional Institution in North Florida.
- FIT has resubmitted an application for program approval by the Florida Department of Corrections for the FIT program as a whole.
- The FIT Policy Committee has been active in setting policies to be followed systemwide.
- The FIT Succession Committee presented its 2020 Succession Policy recommendations to the board and had it approved.
- Helen Campbell continues her two-year ministry at the Life Challenge of Western NC women's center. Seventy-seven course graduations have been issued. Five individuals have completed the entire FIT program
