YES. When you do anything involving online payments you are transferred to another site for processing. We use the SmartCart professional service to securely process all your orders whether they be for books, dues, training fees, or donations. We have been using them for years and found them to be reliable and we do not want to change and have another company acquire your sensitive information. **Florida residents are asked for additional information** because some of our items are taxable and some are not. Florida residents are taxed by different rates depending on their county. That is why you will be asked to choose your county from the drop-down box just before the "Submit Order" button.

For public organizations we welcome people of all faith to get all they can from the practical applications that "serve a secular" purpose" such as our books on best practices in parenting, relationships,

anger management, and financial recovery. For Christian organizations we add relevant spiritual applications from the Bible. Many prefer this holistic approach.

We do not favor one Christian denomination or doctrine over another. We focus on the major Christian topics that are not controversial and directly related to living a consistent Christian life while at the same time teaching people to be of good character and lawabiding citizens.

are most known for our faith-based Life-Skills books and curriculum which have been carefully constructed and updated over the years. Our website at www.familyintegrity.gorg offers a good summary and description of each of our standalone course books which make up our overall program.

Things that set us apart ...

Our emphasis is on the long term - "learn to fish" instead of "give me a fish".

We **network** across regions and types of settings to follow the progress of our clients as much as possible. For example, we just had an individual who took courses with us in Bradenton, FL in a recovery house, took more courses in a prison 500 miles away, got out of prison and returned to Bradenton and just completed our anger management class as a condition of his parole.

Our **record system** tracks every course completion back to 2009 and enables us to print a complete record of all an individual's course completions in that time frame. This could include printing individual records or reprinting certificates for attorneys, judges, parole officers, and with case managers of child custody cases.
