Committees Formed

On April 29, the Board of Directors approved the formation of the following committees.

I. Recruitment

The goal of the Recruitment Committee is to recruit and train leaders, retain the present leadership, develop leadership awards and provide a presence in conferences, communities, as well as churches.

II. Fundraising

This committee will create sponsorships, develop advertising (including social media) and develop a contact pool (foundations, etc.).

III. Succession

The Succession Committee will assist the FIT board in the performance of the board's responsibilities related to succession planning to ensure the continuance of the FIT organization. They will establish and review the overall succession planning process, including emergency succession plans related to the replacement of key FIT positions and senior management. They will have oversight and research replacement issues, develop a list of alternative FIT office sites, develop a list of officer candidates when necessary and develop a continuity book which will contain passwords, procedures and office manual with backup information.

IV. Curriculum

The Curriculum Committee objective is to provide high quality curriculum that meets the needs of our clients, develop curriculum in other languages and train leadership (Peer Facilitators, Facilitators), explore other delivery methods such as Go To Meeting, etc. and provide leadership updates from the Policy Committee.

V. Technology

Keep up with the hardware and software currently in use and troubleshoot/assist when needed.

Another committee, the Policy Committee, is active in reviewing and drafting policies for FIT, takes these policies to the FIT Board and works on other assignments from the president or board.

Committee Members Sought

Family Integrity Training is seeking members willing to serve in any of our committees. You must be a member in good standing. The meetings are held online, so there is no reason to travel. The committee will meet a minimum of twice a quarter with 3 members present. A member in good standing would be those who have paid their annual dues (\$35.00) and are living a committed Christian life according to the guidelines outlined in our course materials. Committee Standards Established

On April 29, the FIT Board approved the establishment of committee minimum standards. The standards are as follows:

- I. Have a minimum of 4 members
- II. Have at least 3 members present at the meeting
- III. Meet twice a quarter
- IV. May include members of FIT in good standing
- V. Board members would be committee chairs
- VI. Submit a report for the board agenda 3 weeks prior to the quarterly meeting
- VII. Each committee would have a mission statement for guidance
