FIT MEMBERSHIP BEGINS JANUARY 1, 2013

In order to be more organized and efficient as well as to open up new ways to serve our mission, FIT is offering membership to those who identify with what we are doing. Our members come from all ways of life and educational levels, but the one thing that unites us is a lifestyle of Christian living. We are non-denominational and stay away from any divisive doctrine that would detract from our Christian testimony or our focus on our Savior Jesus Christ. That being said, we also offer the solid practical help in dealing with life controlling problems like alcoholism, drug addiction, anger management. We also work with prostitutes, parents who have had their children removed, and criminals in jail and prison and those who have been released. We also work with people in the community in dealing loss and grief.

FIT membership begins on January 1, 2013 and will be the basis for distributing the free materials and services that FIT has been so well known for. We are a faith ministry and have to constantly balance our three most major organizational needs: volunteers who will carry out our mission (all of our facilitators are volunteers), institutions who will allow us in to minister, and funds to operate. We struggle with all three areas, but at least the three have been in balance this past year. For a whole year, we have been able to take care of most of the needs of our clients and workers.

The cost of FIT membership is \$25 per calendar year and will be the basis for distributing FIT resources and ensuring our donors that their money is being most efficiently used. A chaplain or third party may request materials or FIT certificates from our website as in the past, but the actual person(s) facilitating the class must be members. Another way of becoming a member is completing our one-day training session and paying the \$35 training fee. That person will then be a member for the rest of the calendar year. We encourage those whose training was a few years ago or more to take advantage of a "refresher" course to bring them up to date with all of the things that have happened since their training session.

Finally, membership will now be open to those who would never feel comfortable ministering in a prison or among street people but would like to help the organization to get that job done. Ways that people can help in very important ways are writing to incarcerated, helping with fundraising, doing phone work or assisting a facilitator in a recovery house or community program.

We hope that many will choose to be FIT members. The \$25 per year will help us financially as well as point out those who are serious about our mission. Members will also be able to participate in the annual business meeting. The next one is Thursday, January 10, 2013 in Lakeland, FL at 1:00-2:00 P.M.
